The past month has been quite uneventful, apart from a flat move, a lost internet connection, establishing links with a local Spanish congregation, and responding to queries about Jesus...

The long awaited flat move finally took place at the beginning of February and that has now opened the opportunity to think through how we use the original flat. As well as congregational activities, we would like to have a facility to welcome volunteers who might want to work alongside us for a month or two, but in the meantime, it is a matter of repainting and preparing it for use.

One casualty of the move however has been our internet connection which has been down for almost a month. Access at Legends has provided a lifeline, but at the time of writing, there is little hope of getting the original connection relocated and we may have to go through the process of terminating one account and looking for a new provider.

The month also saw a reconnection with the Iglesia Cristiana Evangélica Renacer in neighbouring Caleta de Velez. I met with the pastor and began to think through how we might work together to reach out into the local market which draws a wide variety of people



each Thursday. There is much to do in this regard and we are in the very early stages, but the initial contact has been promising, although it might be April before we actually get anything on the ground.

Queries about Jesus should just be the norm...shouldn't they? Apart from the questions that Sunday mornings generate, as we look at the lessons Jesus taught His disciples on the road to Jerusalem, there have been one or two more over the month. It has been a pleasure to respond to queries from people who have yet to encounter the reality of Jesus and to help them grasp the reality of who He is.

Prayer Points

- Pray that we will be able to get the practical issues of the flat use and internet connections resolved.
- Pray for our tentative and fledgling contact with the Renacer congregation, that we will know wisdom in our talking, thinking, planning and praying.
- Pray for our testimony of Jesus, both as a community and in individual contacts, that we may present Him faithfully and with reality.
