The continued links with a local Spanish congregation in Caleta, where, a couple of weeks ago, I had the opportunity to ask if they might be interested in exploring, alongside us, the Moclam theological education course. The response was quite positive. Although it was only an initial proposal, I am hopeful that over the coming weeks we can revisit the idea and start to think about doing it in the autumn.

During March, a woman who has been coming to us for a few months, make a profession of faith in Jesus. It was a timely reminder and encouragement to us, in the run up to Easter, that God is still saving souls.

There has been some agreement on the use of the flat. We hope to commence at Bible study there in April. The flat has many possible uses and we are open to volunteers joining us for a few months. In the meantime, we need to give it a quick coat of paint!

Looking ahead to Easter we have two Billy Graham films planned for Sundays over the Easter period (2nd and 9th) and, if it all goes to plan, some days giving out evangelistic material in the Thursday market over April. In the longer term, we would like to have a joint outreach with the Caleta church, but this will take time



and is not without some hurdles to jump. Nevertheless, I would like to explore the possibilities and see what may come out of the connection.

April will also bring further opportunities to meet with some recent one-to-one contacts that I have made, and I trust that, at the appropriate time, there will be opportunities to share Jesus.
